

INDEMNITY AND GUARANTEE
REISSUED ORIGINAL BILL OF LADING

In consideration of your issuing a duplicate set negotiable Bill of Lading for the above mentioned shipment, original set being unreceived/lost, we hereby undertake to hold you and each of you harmless and keep you and each of you indemnified against all claims which may be made upon you and any of you or each of you under the said Bill of Lading or any of the set of which it forms a part against all loss, costs (as between Attorney or Solicitor and Clients), damages and expenses which you or any of you may suffer or be put to by any reason of signing a duplicate set of Bill of Lading.

If a claim should be raised against you as a consequence of the issuing of this duplicate set of Bill of Lading, we further authorize you to settle such claim direct with the claimant, and we undertake to keep you indemnified for all costs in this respect.

If any proceedings should be commenced in this respect, we undertake to provide you from time to time with sufficient funds to meet your costs to such proceedings.

In case the vessel or any property belonging to you should be arrested for any claim as a consequence of your issuing this duplicate Bill of Lading, we undertake to provide bail to get the vessel or other arrested property released, and to indemnify you for any loss and expenses caused you by the arrest, whether same is justified or not.

This liability of each and every person under this indemnity shall be joint and several and shall not be conditional upon your proceeding first against any person, whether or not such person is party to or liable under this indemnity.

This indemnity shall be constructed in accordance with English Law and each and every person liable under this indemnity shall submit to the jurisdiction of the High Court of Justice of England.
